



## 7<sup>th</sup> Wave Port Erin

Additional Trip Information for Students and Parents:

**PLEASE NOTE: Different arrangements will be in place for the Thursday group and details will be provided separately.**

<b>Trip Leader</b>	Mr Smith
<b>Activity</b>	7th Wave is an RYA Recognised Training Centre, offering dinghy sailing, powerboat and shore based courses in Port Erin. The students will be split into three groups and will take part in three water sport activities: Sailing, Sea Kayaking and Paddle Boarding. <b>This is a whole day activity and you WILL get wet.</b>

<b>Finish:</b>	3:25pm at Lower School
<b>Transport</b>	We will be traveling by bus to Port Erin.
<b>Equipment to bring</b>	If you have your own wetsuit you may bring it with you but Full water sports equipment will be provided. Students will need to bring a towel and a bag to keep their possessions together. You will need to bring a full change of clothes, a swimsuit (for underneath your wetsuit), old trainers (not crocs or flip flops) that will get wet, a towel, lots of water and your lunch. Do not bring anything valuable that could be lost or damaged as the school will not be held liable. You are required to take responsibility for all your own equipment and property.
<b>Meal Arrangements</b>	Bring lots of water and a packed lunch or money to purchase lunch at the café. You may wish to bring a small amount of money to buy an icecream or snack. This is at your own risk, the school will not be responsible for any loss.
<b>PLEASE NOTE:</b>	<b>This activity is weather permitting.</b> A Trip declaration form will be issued to you. This must be completed in full and returned to the school office before Activity Week or your child will not be able to participate on the trip. Please ensure you provide full details of any dietary / medical / physical limitations and requirements.
<b>Acceptance and participation on this trip is subject to adherence to the School's Code of Conduct on behaviour. Any student who has shown, or does show a persistent reluctance to adhere to it, may be removed from the trip without reimbursement.</b>
