Will not accept self-placements and will only offer their placements via the system allocations and shortlisting process.

Will only take students as a self-placement. Students must contact the practice directly and offer to attend to meet with the vet to arrange a short interview before a placement will be agreed.

Take self-placements only, if you have a keen interest in swimming and are a good swimmer then a placement could be requested from Kath Andrews.



### **Working in Primary Schools**

Please do not apply to work in the primary school that you attended- go to a different school that you have not been in before.

Please do not approach 3fm for self-placements, they will not offer more than what they are already providing in the database
