Stick to a routine.

- Be ready and online 5 mins before your lesson is due to start
- 2. Log into the correct Google Classroom for that lesson
- 3. The teacher will post a welcome message at the start of each lesson and then ask you to respond to it so that they know that you are in the lesson
- 4. Tasks will be set
- 5. This is not like a normal lesson so the task will probably span a couple of lessons or more
- 6. Your teacher will be online during your lesson time to answer your questions – post them in the stream as someone else my benefit from the answer to your question too

Tutor time

- Tutor time is really important, it will be our way of staying in touch and sending you important messages
- 2. Log into your tutor Google Classroom 5 mins before the start of tutor time
- 3. The teacher will post a welcome message at the start of each lesson and the ask you to respond to it so that they know that you are in the lesson
- 4. During tutor time you may be set a task or your tutor might decide to use the stream or the question function to instigate a conversation.
- 5. BE PATIENT DURING ONLINE CONVERSATIONS
- 6. USE CORRECT ENGLISH AT ALL TIMES THIS IS A WORKING ENVIRONMENT
- 7. Your tutor will always be online during tutor time if you need them

Top home learning tips

- Don't rush through your work. Home learning goes at a slower pace than in class and we could be doing this for a very long time
- 2. Teachers will try to set you interesting tasks to do that you can easily accomplish at home - try to enjoy these tasks
- 3. Ask for help if you need it
- 4. Take breaks from learning and do something you enjoy
