Instructions:	<p>This is an INDIVIDUAL task</p> <p>You are to investigate the art style "POST IMPRESSIONISM"</p> <p>Start by finding out what Post impressionism is – Find a definition</p> <p>Use the WHO, WHAT, WHERE, WHEN, WHY questions to guide your answer.</p> <p>FIND 1 POST IMPRESSIONIST ARTIST you like (not Van GOGH)</p> <p>Produce a KNOWLEDGE & INVESTIGATION into the artist</p> <p>Use WHO, WHAT, WHERE, WHEN, WHY</p> <p>Find a piece of art work from the artist that you like and produce a study.</p> <p>OPINION – Why did you choose this piece?</p>
Skills:	<p>Knowledge and Investigation -</p> <p>Research and explore</p> <p>Applying the skills taught in lesson to their own pieces.</p> <p>Finding art works that you like</p>
Marking schema:	<p>You will be assessed in the quality of the work you produce and how engaged</p> <p>3levels:</p> <p>BASIC – Facts ripped from the web, no opinions or personal research. Presentation is rushed</p> <p>IMPROVER – Information gathered and own opinion is given. Applying the Knowledge and INVESTIGATION template used in class to show research into an artist. An attempt to copy an art work Presentation is engaged</p> <p>EXCEPTIONAL: Information has been gathered and presented in a creative and engaging manor. Knowledge and INVESTIGATION template has been applied creatively . Study of artists art work is high quality and opinions reflect their understanding.</p>
