Duration:	1 to 1 and 1/2 hours
Hand in:	Week 28
Instructions:	Students are to create a body biography of a Shakespearean character of their choice. It can be done on paper or online. This is an individual task and will require their learnt knowledge from lessons or research if they'd like to find out about a new character. The idea is to get as much information about a character as they can, both openly stated and more inferential understanding of a character. Students will need to find some good quotations relating to their character to support what they write. Draw the outline of a body and present the information visually or if drawing is something you're not a big fan of, you could present it more as a factfile
Skills:	This will require reading skills, research skills and maybe a bit of artistry!
Marking schema:	This task will be something we'd love to use as display work – pieces will not only get you EPraise points, but accolades for pieces that show really excellent effort.
Additional guidance or help:	On Google Classroom there will be examples of work and guidance sheets with ideas on. You can keep it simple or make it as detailed as you like. It can be a character you've studied or one you've found out about yourself from any Shakespeare play.
