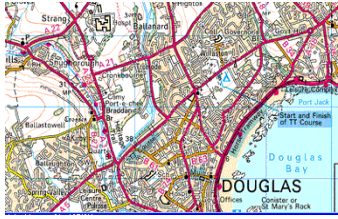


My patch' project Mark scheme



You My Patch project is marked using the grading system from the Skills Ladder. The majority of students will be at level 2 with only exceptional projects achieving a level 4.

Level 1- You will have all or some of the following:

- Some research to highlight the location of your house.
- Sources used but not necessarily labelled or explained.
- You have used a few sources to show where you live
- There is an overall feel that the project is incomplete.

Level 2 – You will have all or some of the following:

- You have researched the area where you live in a clear way.
- Sources have been labelled and explained
- A range of skills have been used such as grid references, labels, points of the compass, use of a key.
- You have used your own work and secondary information
- It is clear where you live and what the surrounding area is like

Level 3 – You will have all or some of the following:

- You have shown in detail where you live with a detailed grid square labelled with a range of features.
- You show a wide range of skills including direction, scale, a key, grid references, latitude and longitude.
- Your work is presented in a logical order.
- Connections are made between where you live and other areas in the Isle of Man.
- A wide range of sources are used to further explain the location of your house and surroundings.

Level 4 – You will need to have covered all in Level 3 as well as:

- Reasonings as to why your house is inter connected to other locations in the Isle of Man and further afield.
- A wide range of primary and secondary sources that are all fully annotated.
- Detailed description of where your sources have come from and some evaluation of their accuracy.
- Accurate Geographical key terms have been used throughout.
- All work independently carried out.
