Instructions:	You are going to choose one famous Hispanic person who somehow has contributed to the Spanish speaking community. You can pretend that you have interviewed the person, and you are now ready to do a presentation using Power Point, Google slides or paper. This Hispanic person can be a singer, an actor or actress, a musician, a sculptor, a painter, a writer or footballer, etc.
Skills:	You need to include the following: Introduction - name of famous person. The real name and celebrity name of the person you are interviewing. Date of his or her death if the person is deceased. What kind of profession he or she does/did. What kind of success they've accomplished through his or her career. Biography: personal history before this person became famous. Major awards or accomplishments of this person. Other pictures or graphics that help people remember this person. Explain why you admire this person.

On a A4 paper with your own drawings, pictures (fold the paper to make it look like a brochure) You could also do it on a PowerPoint slide.
