On Thursday 13th November 2025, the Department of Education, Sport and Culture (DESC) will be holding its annual Employability and Skills Event at the Villa Marina.

This event provides an excellent opportunity to speak with professionals from a wide range of employment sectors, including the creative industries, finance, hospitality, science, technology, engineering, and the uniformed services.

Year II students from St. Ninian's have been allocated a visit session during **Lessons I and 2 on Thursday I3<sup>th</sup> November 2025.** During the visit, students are encouraged to speak to professionals from different sectors about specific job roles, career pathways, and general employability skills, in order to gain a better understanding of potential future opportunities.
