Re: Year 9 PSHE Curriculum

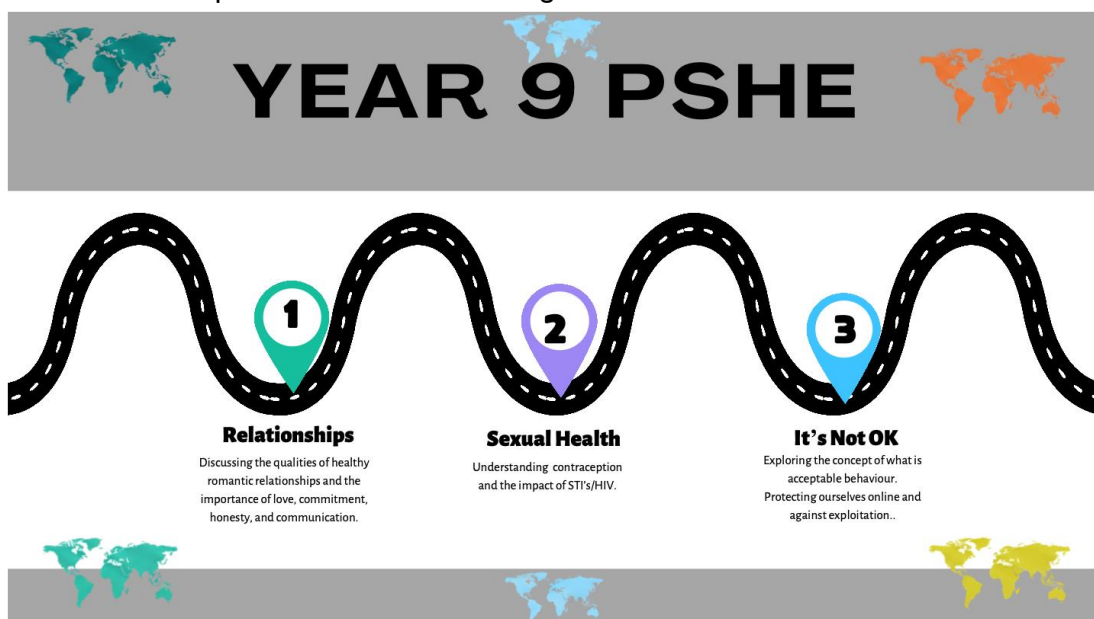
From September 2026 your child will be receiving PSHE lessons as part of their whole school curriculum. This will be facilitated over a few lessons on a rolling basis throughout the year.

PSHE stands for personal, social, health, and economic education, which are the broad areas this important subject covers. PSHE is taught throughout all key stages on the island and focuses on developing the whole child and equipping students with the knowledge, skills, and understanding needed to look after their well-being, make informed decisions, and enjoy positive relationships.

It is important to recognise that PSHE lessons will be delivered by a dedicated team of skilled staff in a manner that is developmentally appropriate and the curriculum will build upon prior learning. The delivery will also be supplemented where possible with 'drop down days' with visiting speakers and outside agencies.

Some units of work within the PSHE curriculum covers Relationships and Sex Education (RSE). The content covered for RSE is directed by PSHE Leads across the island working closely in conjunction with The Department of Education, Sport and Culture (DESC). Lesson plans have been adapted and approved to fit with our aims and values of empowering our students to be self-motivated and confident learners who have respect for others, enabling them to make informed life decisions.
