Re: Parent Information Evening: Spotting the Signs and Responding to Exploitation (Risks Outside the Home)

We would like to invite parents and guardians to an information evening focused on spotting the signs of exploitation and understanding how to respond and support young people.

The session will be led by two experienced Exploitation Workers from Manx Care, who bring significant experience of working with young people both here in the Isle of Man and in wider contexts. Their knowledge and experience will provide an opportunity for parents and guardians to develop a greater understanding of different forms of exploitation, the potential warning signs, and the ways in which young people may be affected.

The evening will include:

- Case studies to help illustrate how exploitation can present itself.
- Information about potential signs and indicators that a young person may be at risk.
- Practical advice and guidance on how parents and guardians can respond.
- Signposting to useful resources and sources of support available to families.
- An opportunity to ask questions and discuss any concerns following the presentation.

The main information session will last approximately one hour, after which there will be an opportunity for parents and guardians to stay and ask questions of the Exploitation Workers.

Time: 5.00pm – 6.00pm

Venue: Lower School Assembly Hall

If you wish to attend, we ask that parents/guardians reserve a place using the Arbor Parent Portal/App where the event has been set up as a Club. Guidance on how to navigate to the event and book your place is included overleaf. Due to capacity seating is limited to a maximum of two adults per booking.

We recognise that exploitation can be a difficult and concerning subject, but having the knowledge and confidence to recognise potential warning signs can play an important role in keeping young people safe and accessing effective early intervention. We would therefore strongly encourage parents and guardians to attend this informative and valuable session.

6. Confirm your registration.
