### Re: Yr 12 & 13 Awards Information

On Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October we will be holding our Annual Presentation of Awards afternoon at the Villa Marina in Douglas. Students are reminded that this is a formal occasion and they will not be permitted to use mobile phones during the ceremony. The arrangements for Year 12 and Year 13 students are below.

#### Arrangements for Year 12 students: Class of 2018 Year 11

9.15 Year 12 students will meet at the Villa Marina to be registered, prior to rehearsals and remain at the Villa Marina for the day. During the lunch break. **They may leave the premises but must be back at the Villa Marina by 12.50 pm and seated by 1 pm.**

Year 12 students who did not attend St. Ninian's for their GCSE studies may have home study for the day, by prior agreement with Mr Schofield, the Head of Sixth Form, or are welcome to attend the ceremony in the afternoon. **They need to be seated by 1pm.**

#### Arrangements for Year 13 students:

8.40 am School starts as normal at Upper School. Students will need their usual school equipment for lessons 1 and 2. Lesson 3 will be a tutorial period with their tutor preparing for the afternoon. Normal Sixth Form dress code applies.

Break The canteen will only be serving food at lunchtime but students will be able to use the canteen and Coffee Shop to eat any snacks at break.

11.45 am There will be an early lunch with the canteen serving food as usual. Year 13 are allowed off site at lunchtime as usual and are requested to make their own way to the Villa Marina for 12.50 pm. **They will be registered and should be in their allocated seats by 1 pm.**

1.30 pm The ceremony will commence.

3.25 pm All students will be dismissed from the Villa Marina. Usual school buses will be available for students at the Villa Marina or students may meet parents and/or walk home.

#### Sixth Form Award winners, Public Speaking Team, Performance Group or Band

All students involved in any of the above should start the day at the Villa Marina. They will not need school equipment but should be in appropriate Sixth Form dress. These students are allowed off the Villa Marina premises to make their own arrangements at lunchtime. Seating will be available for any students who wish to bring a packed lunch but the vending machines will not be available for use. **All students must be back at the Villa Marina at 12.50 pm and in their allocated seats by 1 pm.**
