**Re: History revision and exam preparation**

I am writing to inform you of the opportunities available to help students prepare for their final examinations. History is a demanding subject as there is a large amount of knowledge that students have to understand and commit to memory, in addition to developing the skills required to successfully answer complex questions.

All lessons between now and the exams are required to cover the remainder of the course. It is imperative, therefore, that students take advantage of the additional opportunities we are offering, as well as studying at home, to review their learning, learn the key content and practice the necessary exam techniques.

On Tuesday and Wednesday lunchtimes we are offering study sessions on “The League of Nations” and “Were the Peace Treaties fair?” On Thursdays there is a “Flash card revision session”, aimed at helping students with the techniques of learning content.

Every Wednesday, after school, we are running a study session (15:40 – 16:30) during which we will recap the topics that relate to paper 4 (they will also benefit paper 1)

And finally on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May from 9.10am-12.50pm and Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 9.10am-12.50pm, we have planned study sessions to support students in their preparation for the sourced based exam on Containment. The exam takes place on the 17<sup>th</sup> May and is worth 33% of the final grade. We feel that these sessions will be extremely beneficial, but if for any reason a student cannot make one of these sessions, please contact a history teacher to discuss what alternative arrangements can be made.

I hope that students and parents will take some time at home to discuss a revision plan in relation to History and to commit to attending as many History study sessions as possible, in particular the study sessions relating to the source exam.
